FLORIDA LITERACY COACH ENDORSEMENT

The Florida Department of Education's Practice Profiles clearly define the best practices of core reading instruction in a way that is teachable, learnable, doable, and assessable in practice. These practice profiles are research-based, aligned to effective reading instruction, and related to Florida's Benchmarks for Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards.



READING PROGRAM REPOSITORY

The Reading Program Repository was established to support Florida Local Education Agencies (LEAs) with being good consumers of research when selecting reading programs that best meet the needs of their students. The collection of reading programs listed in this repository is based on LEA program selections through the High-Quality Reading Curriculum Grant and is expanded annually to include programs submitted in District Comprehensive Evidence-Based Reading Plans.



SCHOOL LEADER'S LITERACY WALKTHROUGH FOR GRADES K-12

The School Leader's Literacy Walkthrough tool is designed to assist school leaders in grades K-12 in supporting classroom literacy instruction and is aligned to Florida's B.E.S.T. English Language Arts Standards. For the purposes of this tool, school leaders may include principals, assistant principals, literacy coaches, members of the literacy leadership team, teacher leaders or others.



ESSENTIALS FOR READING SUCCESS

Essentials for Reading Success is a website designed to provide educators with more in-depth guidance on aspects of effective, evidence-based reading instruction. This ever-growing resource includes information about using assessment data to make instructional decisions, applying response to intervention to support learners, delivering effective instruction (including differentiated instruction), and implementing evidence-based practices to teach the critical components of reading. Teachers, instructional coaches, and other educators can use the site individually or in groups to continuously improve their practice.
