Objective

The student will segment syllables in words.



Student sheet

Choose target syllable pattern(s). When mapping VCE syllables, the "e" is placed below the final grapheme with a slash and an arrow is drawn leading back to the vowel that it is making long.

Pencil

Activity

Students map graphemes to phonemes and mark syllables within words.

- 1. Provide the student with a student sheet.
- 2. Student writes each word using phoneme-grapheme mapping (i.e., one grapheme per box).
- 3. Underlines each vowel (i.e., single, r-controlled, and vowel teams).
- 4. Swoops the syllables underneath the letters.
- 5. Continues until the student sheet is complete.
- 6. Teacher evaluation
