Phonological Awareness

Phoneme Matching

Sound Bags

Objective

The student will match medial phonemes in words.




Materials

- Paper bag
- Pairs of objects with the same medial sounds Place one object from each pair in the bag.

Activity

Students match objects with the same medial sound.

- 1. Place the bag and the objects at the center.
- 2. Taking turns, student one pulls out an object, names it, and says the medial sound (e.g., "comb, /ō/").
- 3. Student two finds the object that has the matching medial sound, names it, and says the medial sound (i.e., "goat, $/\bar{o}/$ "). Puts the matching pair aside.
- 4. Continue until all objects are paired.
- 5. Peer evaluation



Extensions and Adaptations

- ▶ Use initial or final sound objects.
- Use medial sounds of a pair of objects as clues and partner identifies objects.

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
