AK12 Emergent Writing

Writing My Name



Objective

The child will begin to write own name (first, last, or nickname).



Materials

- Sensory materials (e.g., sand, shaving cream, and play dough)
- Whiteboards
- Dry Erase markers and erasers
- Paint and paintbrushes
- Paper
- Writing Utensils
- Child Name Cards



Activity

After teacher introduction, children begin to write own name using a variety of materials.

- 1. Set out Child Name Cards face up on the table.
- 2. Prepare a sensory tub such as sand, play dough, or shaving cream.
- 3. Set out other materials for writing names.
- 4. Children select their name card from the table.
- 5. Pick three ways to practice writing from the choices set out.
- 6. Teacher evaluation.



Adaptations and Extensions

- Make name cards with raised puff paint or colored glue for the children to trace with a finger.
- · Start by writing the first letter in name. Gradually increase to writing complete name.
- Choose one way to write name.
- Add last name.
- Trade with a friend and write a friend's name.
- Take the activity outside to write names with chalk on a sidewalk.
