Objective

The child will use adjectives to describe objects.



Materials

- Classroom objects Choose eight classroom objects (e.g., eraser, chalk, block, ball, etc.).
- Two Bags Place four objects in each bag.



Activity

After teacher introduction, children use descriptive word clues to identify objects.

- 1. Place the bags of objects at the center.
- 2. Working in pairs, child one selects one of the objects in the "Child One" bag, and uses descriptive words to describe it to child two (e.g., "It is a rectangle and is black and soft").
- 3. Using the clues, child two attempts to name the object.
- 4. If the object is named, child two removes it from the bag. If not named, the object remains in the bag.
- 5. Reverse roles and continue until all objects are identified.
- 6. Peer evaluation
